The remainder of the construction project to complete the new clubrooms and change-rooms is still underway and

we are advised this will be finished by the end of March. In the meantime, there will be some temporary toilet facilities available. Unfortunately, we will be without change-rooms and showers for a few more months, so swimmers please make necessary arrangements to manage around this.

The heating of the pool at Newman College marks the beginning of a new chapter in our club's 40-year history and we're sure you will enjoy the benefits for many years to come.


